Introduce an accurate, integrated barcoding system that helps you pick items faster than ever, and gives you complete visibility of what stock is available and where.

Use handheld devices to eliminate manual and timeconsuming tasks - such as keying in individual items when receipting purchases - to speed up processes and reduce the risk of human error.

Pick items via the most efficient routes depending on location and priority with directed picks. If an order is for Next Day Delivery or has specific temperature requirements, the system will direct you to pick those at the most appropriate point.

Keep the whole business up-to-date on product availability. As soon as an item has been picked, stock levels are immediately updated and potential customer dissapointments are avoided.
